Irregular Verbs

Usually you add *-ed* to a verb to show past tense. **Irregular verbs** do not follow this rule. Irregular verbs change to other words to show past tense.

Present Tense

Past Tense

Past with has, have, or had

This book teaches me a lesson.

This book taught me a lesson.

This book has taught me a lesson.

Irregular verbs have a special form when they are used with *has*, *have*, or *had*. Below are some irregular verbs and their past forms.

Present Tense	Past Tense	Past with has, have, or had
bring	brought	(has, have, had) brought
choose	chose	(has, have, had) chosen
come	came	(has, have, had) come
do	did	(has, have, had) done
feel	felt	(has, have, had) felt
get	got	(has, have, had) gotten
give	gave	(has, have, had) given
go	went	(has, have, had) gone
make	made	(has, have, had) made
say	said	(has, have, had) said
speak	spoke	(has, have, had) spoken
teach	taught	(has, have, had) taught
